FOREWORD

Welcome to our 34th Annual R2 Bull Sale and 69 years of breeding (Est. 1955).

What a difference a year makes. For the last two years it has been extremely wet but this season has been the complete opposite. We've tried to take full advantage of the dry spell by having the digger here for four months, fencing up paddocks again and getting on top of animal health. We've stayed green pretty much right through the summer and autumn. Grass hasn't got away like it has in previous years but its meant we've ticked off other jobs. Lambs still struggled to get going out of spring however the cattle have done well with excellent in-calf rates.

We are very proud of the catalogue of bulls put forward. The group show a great deal of evenness and natural do-ability. Rosskeen and Waimoana provide an excellent testing ground for both the cattle and sheep which gives us confidence that they will stand up and produce quality results wherever they go.

This year we are offering more bulls due to the increase in scale and quality coming through. We will continually put forward between 40-50 bulls a year. This years line up of bulls have been developing true strength on the hills. We are breaking away from the pampering and over feeding as it doesn't do any favours for when the bulls have to go back to genuine hill country conditions. The genetics on offer will add value to any program at any stage whether it is selling weaners, selling yearlings or finishing prime cattle. All of our bulls are sold to hill country farmers so what better way to grow and finish them on hill country at 450m+ asl. They'll arrive ready to perform and prosper. If you're a hill country farmer looking for strong grunty hill country genetics, this sale will be well worth your time!

Our cow herd is very much run under commercial conditions and are there to do the job of cleaning up rank pastures throughout the year - no special treatment here. This year we will be calving down 310 cattle (including 70 commercial cows) and lambing 2,300 ewes with 750 ewe hoggets plus carrying all replacement stock. Our goal is to be all stud cattle in two to three years which will enable us to provide a top selection of bulls. Winter stocking rate sits around 9.5 - 10 su/ha so the studs very much have to fit in and cope under constant pressure.

We have tonnes of growth and frame in the background of our herd so we'll be looking to continue to thicken up and source sires that will suit our breeding program. Our goal going forward is to breed a medium-plus sized fertile cattle beast that holds condition and produces quiet progeny that will perform year in, year out. We have been impressed with the sire lines on display in this catalogue with a few new bloodlines coming forward. We are excited about the future direction of Ratanui and the genetics we've been selecting for.

All sale bulls will be videoed prior to sale and posted on our YouTube channel: Ratanui Angus. The bulls will be sold in lot order on a projector screen/live auction combo (including Bidr) inside our wool shed. The sale bulls will still be penned up for viewing on sale day as per normal. Feel free to give us a call if you want to view the bulls prior to sale day or discuss the sale - our front gate is always open! Free delivery within North Island and freight paid to Feilding for South Island purchases.

We've had awesome feedback this year from several clients about how the bulls are performing with very high in-calf rates, quiet meaty progeny being weaned and cattle that are growing out heavy and achieving high % for handpicked programs (330kg - 400kg carcass weights). We would like to sincerely thank all of our loyal supporters and purchasers of Ratanui bulls throughout the years. All the very best for the coming season and we look forward to seeing you on our sale date and time **Friday 21st of June for a 2pm sale.**

CONDITIONS OF SALE

- The term “lot” shall apply to anything offered for sale.
- The highest bidder for any lot shall be the purchaser. Should any dispute arise, this dispute may be settled by the auctioneer at his option, or the lot may be put up again and re-sold.
- The bidding from time to time shall be regulated by the auctioneer, and no bid shall be retracted.
- The vendor shall have the right to one bid only, such bid shall be the reserve bid, previous instruction notwithstanding.
- Each lot shall be at the risk of the purchaser immediately on the fall of the hammer.
- No lot shall be taken delivery of, or removed from the yards, by the purchaser without first obtaining a delivery order, signed by the auctioneers or the purchaser giving permission for such removal.
- **INSURANCE:** FMG will provide a 14 day free cover on the fall of the hammer. Further FMG insurance options will be available on sale day and purchasers are recommended to take advantage of this.
- Title does not pass until payment has been made in full. Terms are 14 days. Interest at 21% per annum will be charged from the date of purchase on overdue accounts.
- **PURCHASING REBATE:** All intending purchasers must register at the sales office or online prior to the sale. Commission paid to non-participating companies of 6% who introduce buyers to the sale and settle on their behalf within 14 days.
- **TRANSFERS:** Please request eligibility from vendor or vendors’ agent before or on day of sale.
- **FREE DELIVERY:** Within North Island and to Feilding for South Island purchases

NOTICE TO BUYERS

- All bulls have been inspected by Angus Breed Inspectors
- All bulls have been fertility tested and inspected by a senior vet (East Coast Farm Vets - certificate attached)
- All bulls are Group BREEDPLAN recorded, HD50K (genomically tested) and Sire Verified
- All bulls have tested B.V.D. negative and have been fully vaccinated - booster vaccine received
- All bulls have received a 10 in 1 Covexin injection, vaccinated for leptospirosis and given a 36g copper cap
- Ratanui is a TB and Brucellosis Accredited Free herd - **TB status C10**
- Ratanui successfully mates yearling heifers
- All bulls are pedigree and tested free of any known genetic defects
- To our knowledge all precautions have been taken to eliminate potential hazards, but all care should be taken to ensure personal safety. Ratanui is not liable for any damage/injury whilst on our property. Under the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 we are required to advise you of possible hazards:
 - Cattle and vehicle movements
 - Electric fences
 - Stairs and Ramps
 - Woolshed seating
 - Cooking areas
 - Slippery surfaces
 - Trip hazards
 - No unsupervised children in bull viewing pens
- All purchasers are to fill out trucking instruction slips at the back of the catalogue and return them to the registrar before leaving the property.
- Trucking is arranged and paid for by Ratanui. This is usually within 2-3 days after sale (unless told otherwise)

CARING FOR YOUR NEW BULL

At Ratanui the sire that you select and purchase has come from a single mob of 35 bulls, all having been handled quietly and with care.

NB Importantly on arrival at home, make sure you have a quiet mate in the yards to help him settle. Don't put him into a mob of older bulls. He will be used to a bite of good quality hay.

Close attention over mating is advised to quickly detect any problems that may occur, i.e. lameness, infections and any abnormal serving issues.

When the season is finished, the bull should be drenched and put away on good feed. Adequate feed will help bulls settle and help prevent fighting.

Good stockmanship, commonsense & caring for your young bull, especially within the first twelve months, will ensure that he will give good service and mature into a good strong sire.



RATANUI GUARANTEE

All bulls put up for sale are guaranteed fertile and structurally sound for breeding purposes for 3 years from date of purchase.

- In any such case of infertility or unsoundness, the vendor or vendor's agent must be notified as soon as possible
- A full Veterinary Certificate will be required to detail issues preventing the bull from mating
- The purchaser will be refunded by the way of credit at subsequent sales - without interest, expenses, costs or damages, and also taking into account salvage/killing revenue
- The amount credited will decrease by one third of sale price each year
- The purchaser shall throughout the guarantee period provide the bull with sufficient and proper care and given the necessary attention to ensure the bull maintains good health and condition
- BVD vaccinations must be up to date and carried out yearly
- Any dispute shall be settled by an arbitrator appointed by the Auctioneers
- Purchaser to notify vendor prior to disposal of bull unless for humane reasons.

RATANUI'S HISTORY

This year it is Ratanui's 34th annual bull sale and 69 years of breeding quality Angus cattle. It all started in 1955 with Jack Evans purchasing a select group of females, some of which were imported from Scotland for the Chitty Family of Tuakau. This founded the Ardmore Stud. The herd was then taken over by Peter Northcott in 1965 and renamed Renata Angus. Dominant early stud sires were *Dollar of Omakere* and *Jex IV*. In 1978, the complete stud was brought by Dick and Averil Story and was renamed Ratanui Angus Stud.

Dick enjoyed the art of breeding and took great pride in producing quality active hill country bulls. He used multiple leading sires at the time such as *Springdale Brosco*, *Springdale Bonzo 288*, *Te Mania Guardian*, *Te Mania 'Frank' B8.82* to name a few.

Mel and Nicky purchased the stud from Mel's parents Dick and Averil in 2003 and shifted to Tolaga Bay in 2005. They managed to secure a spot in the East Coast bull week and sold their bulls at Matawhero saleyards for 13 years. The call was made to build a sale complex on farm and had three on farm sales in Tolaga Bay.

Together we arrived at a crossroads as to the next step for Ratanui and the Tolaga Bay farm. The decision was made to forge ahead and relocate the stud to Rosskeen Station inland from Wairoa. This has provided us with scale and a great opportunity for our families. Since moving here in 2022, we've held two successful on farm bull and ram sales and purchased the neighbouring farm 'Waimoana'.

VISUAL APPRAISAL IS STILL ESSENTIAL FOR SELECTING BULLS

- **MASCULINE TRAITS** - A strong head, jaw and thick neck indicate high levels of libido, testosterone and reproductive efficiency.
- **NECK LENGTH** - A thick necked animal matures and reaches puberty earlier and has more libido. A longer neck indicates a higher maintenance animal that is slower to reach puberty and re-breed.
- **HEART GIRTH** - Larger heart girth is an indicator of vigor and easy keeping ability. Small heart girth animals are more susceptible to stress, are higher maintenance and do not perform well.
- **STRUCTURAL SOUNDNESS** - Feet, bone and strength of spine - Hill country cattle often cover large distances over rugged terrain so a strong skeleton is essential.
- **REPRODUCTIVE** - A good sheath, nice sized and shaped testicles are essential. Bigger is better.
Larger scrotal = more testosterone = more muscle mass produced.
- **FLANK** - Deep flanked animals are easier keeping, have more meat in the rump and have more maternal and reproductive efficiency.

NOTE: Higher flanked animals tend to be higher maintenance and take longer to finish on grass.

All EAST COAST ANGUS BULLS have been inspected by a qualified Angus Association inspector prior to sale. This means that the animal has passed a minimum standard with relation to:

- Structural Soundness
- Feet
- Jaw
- Angus Breed type
- Frame size
- Capacity
- Reproductive traits
- Sheath
- Testicles
- Temperament

This inspection service is offered by Angus New Zealand to breeding members as a form of quality assurance and indicates that the animal has passed inspection on the specific day it was viewed. The bull buyer can then buy with confidence knowing that all the above points have been considered. Look out for the Approved Status logo in breeders catalogues this year: your guarantee of quality.

BULL FERTILITY SOUNDNESS CHECK

RATANUI ANGUS

On the 12th April 2024, all of the Ratanui Angus bulls on offer were presented for a crush side examination to ensure that no anatomical abnormalities of the reproductive organs were present



BVD

All bulls have been blood tested free of Bovine Viral Diarrhoea virus (BVD)

TESTES

The testicles were palpated to ensure the presence of two symmetrical, turgid testes with no lumps or deformities

PENILE SOUNDNESS

Protrusion of the penis was obtained by electrostimulation and the penis and prepuce were inspected for persistent frenulum, signs of disease, damage or deviations

SEMEN EVALUATION

A semen sample was collected and evaluated for progressive motility, morphology and density. All semen was assessed under oil emersion magnification through Eosin/Nigrosin staining

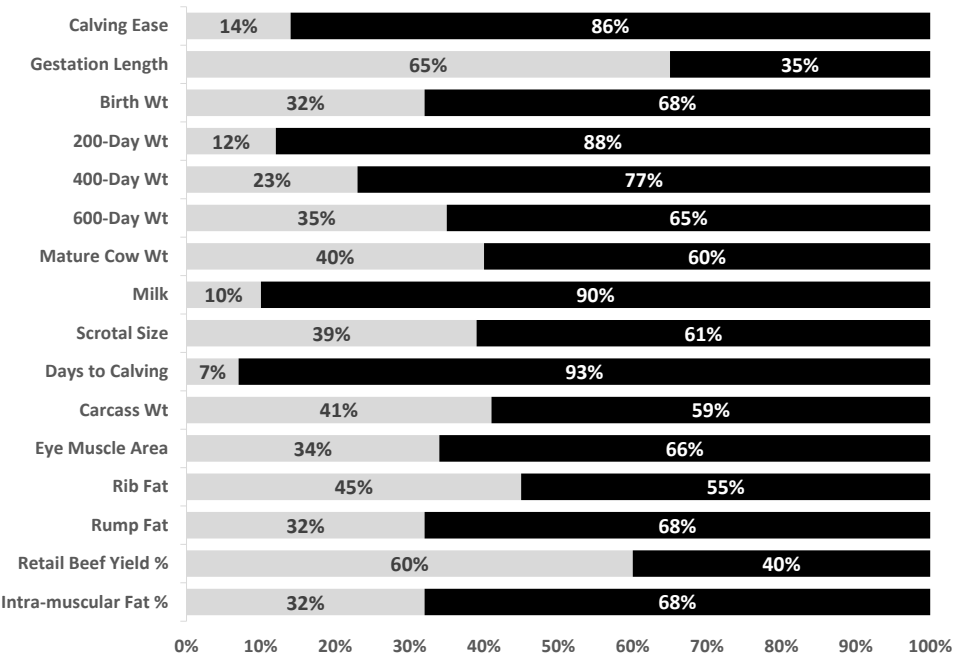
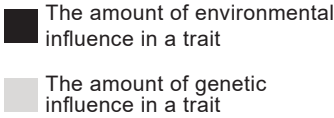
HERITABILITIES OF TRAITS IN ANGUS GROUP TACE (TransTasman Cattle Evaluation)

Only part of the variation that we observe among animals is due to genetic differences. **The majority of the variation is generally due to non-genetic factors such as differences in environment and nutrition.**

The degree to which genetic differences influence performance varies from trait to trait. This is explained by differences in the “heritability” of the traits.

Growth and carcass traits tend to have moderate to high heritabilities (i.e. 20 to 60%), whilst maternal traits have low heritabilities (10% or lower).

Angus TACE takes into account the different degrees of heritability of various traits, and the known genetic relationships between the traits.

MANAGING BVD IN YOUR HERD

BVD is a Pestivirus that infects cattle, usually between the ages of 6 months and 2 years. The main impact of BVD is on breeding animals.

How do cattle contract the virus?

- The virus is spread by direct contact with an infected animal.
- A Persistently Infected Carrier (PI) animal is born after their mother is infected for the first time with the BVD virus, between 1 & 4 months of pregnancy.
- All calves born to PI animals will be PI's themselves.

Is BVD treatable?

- The disease is not directly treatable. In normal healthy animals, BVD is usually a short lived disease, which the animal recovers from by itself.
- Normal healthy animals may scour for a few days and experience a check in growth rate.
- Bulls may be temporarily infertile.
- Pregnant cows or heifers, depending on the stage of pregnancy may show empty, abort the fetus, give birth to weak, sickly or deformed calves, give birth to PI carrier animals or give birth to a normal antibody positive calf.
- PI carrier animals often appear normal until they develop 'mucosal disease' (fever, ulceration of gums, esophagus and entire digestive tract). Mucosal disease in PI animals is always fatal and all PI animals should be culled as soon as they are identified.
- The only way to determine the BVD status of your herd is by blood testing. Discuss options with your vet. To protect your herd against BVD it is advised to bring in no outside animal unless it has been tested clear of the BVD virus. This is particularly true of breeding bulls. Most stud breeders have BVD programmes in place and do pre-sale BVD/EBL testing. Always check before you purchase a bull.
- To avoid temporary infertility in your sires if exposed to BVD while out with the cow, always give them a booster vaccine prior to mating.

GENETIC DEFECTS IN ANGUS

Arthrogryposis Multiplex (AM) and Neuropathic Hydrocephalus (NH) Contractual Arachnodactyly (CA)

AM, NH and CA are simple recessive gene defects, caused by the presence of a single pair of inherited genes. The red gene in Angus cattle is a common example of recessive inheritance – the gene must be present on both sides of the pedigree for full expression.

If a carrier sire and a carrier dam are mated, 25% of the progeny will be clear of the defect, 50% will be carriers, and 25% will be affected.

A DNA test has been developed to identify carrier animals so these defects can be eliminated from the breed.

After such DNA testing, you will be given one of two results;

- AMF, NHF or CAF = tested free of the gene
- AMC, NHC or CAC= tested carriers of the defect.

But, to assist with the identification of carrier animals (prior to DNA testing) a 'probability test' has been developed - using updated test results and animals' pedigrees, known as Geneprob. Geneprob will identify 'at risk' animals in the breed database and assign them a status for AMS or NHS as follows;

- AMFU, NHFU and/or CAFU = free by pedigree inference, untested
- AMS %, NHS% and/or CAS% = a suspected carrier (% = level of suspicion) but un-tested. Requires testing to validate true status
- AMF ,NHF and/or CAF = tested free of the defect
- AMC, NHC and/or CAC = tested carrier of the defect

These GeneProb analysis tests are performed every seven days. Geno typing for these mutations should, with 100% accuracy, expedite elimination of these genes from the Angus population. If you are unsure of any aspect of these genetic defects please enquire of your bull supplier or ring the NZ Angus Association on 06 323 4484.

Angus NZ EBV's Explained

TransTasman Angus Cattle Evaluation (TACE) EBVs and selection indexes remove the effects of non-genetic factors (e.g. feeding regimes, animal age) from what is seen and measured to provide the best measure of an animal's genetic merit. TACE information should always be used in conjunction with other selection criteria, including visual assessment.

A TACE Guide to Animal Selection allows you to select the best genetics for your herd in four easy steps:

1. Identify the **Angus New Zealand selection index** of most relevance to you.
2. **Rank animals** using the chosen selection index.
3. Consider the individual EBVs of importance.
4. Consider other traits of importance (e.g. visual assessment).

If you would like to discuss an alternative timeframe, please have a chat with your local FMG representative.

You don’t have to pay today, FMG will invoice you for this additional cover.

What are the benefits?

✓ <i>Infertility</i>	Cover if your specified bull has to be euthanised due to permanent infertility caused by certain accidents, disease, or illness.
